SUNDAY, MAY 3 - CHANGE YOUR LIFE BY CHANGING YOUR MIND

Romans 12:2; Proverbs 4:23

The New Living Translation of Romans 12:2 says this: *“Do not be conformed to the pattern of this world but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think.”*

God is far more interested in changing your mind than in changing your circumstances.

SUNDAY, MAY 10 - HOW TO DEAL WITH HOW YOU FEEL

Mark 12:29-30

This week we will take a look at your emotional health. That is how to deal with how you feel. Most people are not good at managing their emotions. They're not good at it at all. But you can. And if you do you will have enormous advantages over the other people in your life if you know how to manage your emotions.

SUNDAY, MAY 17 - FACING THE FEARS THAT RUIN RELATIONSHIPS

Genesis 2 and 3

There are three fundamental fears that started in the first relationship when sin entered are still present in your life and everybody else's life and they damage and they destroy potential in any relationship. Despite these fears, every day I need to learn to live in God's love. Every day I remember the way God loves me. Every day I offer my love to others in return.

SUNDAY, MAY 24 - TRANSFORMING HOW I SEE & USE MONEY

Luke 16

It may surprise you that Jesus actually talked more about money than he did about heaven or hell. In fact, half of all of the parables that Jesus told are about money. The reason why this is a confusing passage is because it appears that Jesus is approving dishonesty. He's not. He just uses a clever crook as the hero of the story. And he's using it for shock value. Let's see what's up with that.

SUNDAY, MAY 31 - FACING GIANTS IN LIFE & WORK

1 Samuel 17

It's unlikely that you're ever going to have to face a physical giant like David did. But it is highly likely that you're going to have to face a whole lot of other common giants. In today's lesson we will deal with the giants of delay, discouragement, disapproval and doubt. Overcoming these giants will go a long way towards helping us be the people God intends us to be.

TRANSFORMED

“Transformed” is a church-wide, 7-session/8 week campaign that will guide and grow your church by exploring what the Bible has to say about every essential area of our lives: Spiritual, Physical, Mental, Emotional, Relational, Financial, and Vocational.

The world is shouting for our attention with answers to our relationship struggles, solutions to our financial trouble, and explanations to our search for meaning. But the world's promises leave us empty and searching for more. God's Word is the only answer that promises to transform our lives from the inside out.

Transformed Workbook: This all-in-one journal is the hub of engagement for your participants during the campaign. Workbook contains the study guide for all 7 small group lessons, a daily devotional for each day during the campaign (49 total), space for weekly sermon notes, and suggestions for further study based on each week's topic. *Note: You do not need the Transformed workbook to attend “REFLECTION.”* It will, however, totally enhance your transformational journey. Transformed workbooks can be picked up at the Welcome Center beginning Sunday, April 5. We are asking a \$10 donation per book.
